Get involved! You can help establish a positive future for the region.

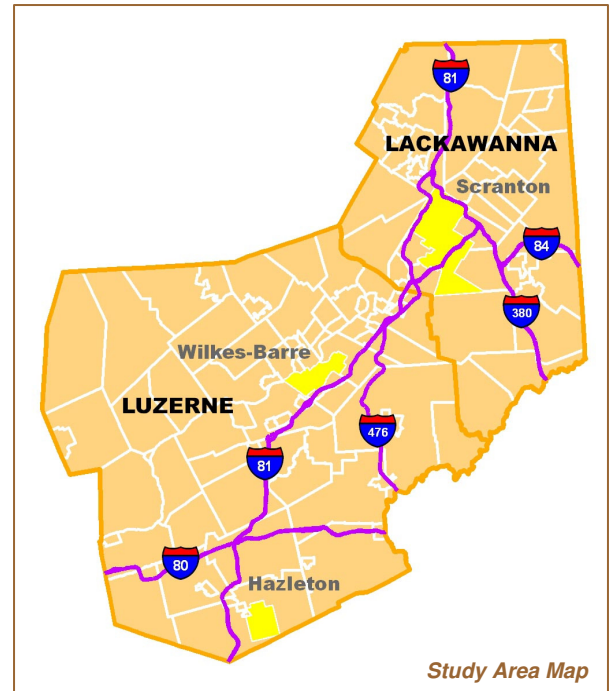
Home to over a half-million people in 116 municipalities, both **Lackawanna and Luzerne Counties** offer something for everyone.
